A perfect space or a dream space means different things to different people. As designers, our biggest pet peeve is clutter. We love open and serene spaces that exude calmness. Whites are our all time favourites. While designing this contemporary dream room, we were thinking "quasi-vintage", "pastel", "spa-like" and "chic".

White wooden flooring and white wooden closets (with mirrors) form most of the shell which is offset by two pale ochre walls. The yellow adds warmth to an otherwise cool shell and the steel grey furniture with brighter mustard and black accents imbues the room with just enough colour. The bedroom has a monochromatic theme running along with the presence of soft white lighting.
